Chocolate connoisseurs

Attention chocolate lovers and Johnny Depp fans. A new movie will confirm what you already know: There's something magic about chocolate — and something very sexy about Depp. (Or is it the other way around?) The movie Chocolat opens Friday at Regal Cinemas.

At a recent screening, movie lover Richie Pollock of Hollywood said he attended because he's a chocoholic and proud of it. He can remember his first Tootsie Roll in Brooklyn when he was about 2 years old, he says. That was 48 years ago.
